

This map illustrates morphological conditions of full water bodies which are affected by morphological alterations. The exact locations of individual water body alterations are not visualised. On transboundary river water bodies, values of morphological classes are reported separately for each other. In case of overlapping symbols of morphological classes, they are drawn on top of each other in this order (top to bottom): 4-5, 2-5, 3, 1-2, 1.
