

### **Target audience**







### Reasons why getting the stakeholders involved









# To which extent the implementation of ND and CAP addresses agricultural international for the Protection of the Danube River. der Donau impacts on water?




# To which extent the WFD objectives are affected by agricultural practices?






# Where the most of the farm practical management advice is targeted?






## Barriers to a more effective system of farm advisory services
