# The main project objective

To mitigate consequences of floods through achieving consistent and holistic management of flood risk in Bodrog river catchment countries (SK-HU-UA) by creating partnerships between national and local levels.





#### **Project activities**

- 1. Formulation of the "Strategy for mitigation of floods for Bodrog River Basin countries"
- 2. Improvement of conditions on former floodplains and wetlands
- Creation of local partnerships: Municipalities, river basin organizations, NGOs, farmers, urban planning authorities
- 4. Dissemination of project results







# Proposals for restoration on demonstration sites

- Demonstration site in Slovakia in Senne depression on Čierna Voda River, a tributary of the Laborec
- Demonstration site in Hungary in the lower section of the Bodrog River with a horse-shoe shaped oxbow called Viss-Oxbow, at the outskirts of Olaszliszka, Viss and Sárazsadány settlements
- A third demonstration site is planned in Ukraine along the Latoriza river












#### Slovakia Okna river "Sluice gate" Will be reconstructed

#### Pilot demonstration site in Hungary – the Bodrog River -Viss-Oxbow area






