EU Water Policy



• Water Framework Directive (2000/60/EC):

- overall framework for integrated management
- ambitious objectives (e.g. good status by 2015)
- basic measures (directives on urban wastewater, nitrate pollution, industry pollution and others)
- protected areas (directives on bathing water, habitats, drinking water and others)

Completing the framework:

- Groundwater (2006/118/EC)
- Priority Substances (negotiations ongoing)

Extending the scope:

- Floods Directive (negotiations ongoing)
- Marine Strategy Directive (negotiations ongoing)
- Communication on Water Scarcity and Droughts

What is it?

- -RBMP is about preserving and improving the environment and introducing sustainable water management
- -RBMP is the core element of the directive 2009 is the most important deadline
- -RBMP can serve different purposes (reporting, planning instrument, public participation)
- -Time until 2009 to improve past and current practices and fill remaining gaps

What will be in it?

- -environmental objectives
- -programme of measures
- -public participation
- -general description of the characteristics
- -summary of significant pressures and impacts
- -results monitoring programmes

Principles

- 1-flexibility in WFD objective setting
- 2-integration with other policies
- 3-consider a wide range of measures
- 4-transparency in decision making

Objective setting

- -heavily modified and artificial water bodies
- -exemptions for new modifications Art 4.7
- -extended deadlines Art. 4.4
- -less stringent objectives Art. 4.5



Integration with other policies

- -co-ordination / integration of sectoral plans
- -early development of common visions
- -international commissions for river protection and navigation can play an important role



Challenges



Towards first RBMP

- -Improve methodologies and close data gaps
- -Apply Article 4.7, the WFD impact assessment, to new infrastructure projects
- -Apply economic instruments more widely
- -Use public participation as an opportunity
